CONSTITUTION of the STATE of COLARUS

I, Mothem, President and Founder of this nation, in order to bring structure to the Colarusian government, hereby ordain this Constitution of the State of Colarus.

I. BASIC PROVISIONS

The State of Colarus is a sovereign, constitutional Presidency; Power is held in the National Council and President.

The capital of the State of Colarus shall be the Administrative Capital of Colarus.

PROVISIONS ON CITIZENSHIP

All Citizens of The State of Colarus shall have the following rights.

- a. The right to express oneself or one's views through speech or expression,
- b. The right to keep and bear arms, concealed or unconcealed,
- c. The right to practice any religion,
- d. The right to protest the government,
- e. The right to own private property and public property,
- f. The right to life and to have one's life protected from taking by third parties,

CONSTITUTION of the STATE of COLARUS

Any application submitted for citizenship, when accepted, automatically incurs the right of citizenship to the citizen.

PROVISIONS ON NATIONAL SYMBOLS

The flag of Colarus shall consist of two red horizontal stripes, a “C” symbol in the center, have a white stripe and outline around the symbol, and have a 2:3 ratio, as described in [this image](#)

The emblem of Colarus shall consist of a heater-style shield divided into twelve equal triangular sections alternating between silver-white and red radiating from the center, charged with a central laurel wreath whose colors are inverted against the background sections, as described in [this image](#)

PROVISIONS ON NATIONAL CURRENCY

The United States Dollar shall be the national currency.

II. TERRITORY

The national territory shall consist of these territories, [as described in this document](#).

III. FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

The federal government shall consist of the Executive Authority and the National Council.

EXECUTIVE AUTHORITY

The President shall be the head of the Executive authority.

The President shall serve for a lifetime unless impeached or resigned.

The President has the power to appoint and remove ministers.

CONSTITUTION of the STATE of COLARUS

The President can veto laws or decisions from the National Council.

NATIONAL COUNCIL

The National Council shall consist of secretaries from different ministries and the president.

The National Council is responsible for organizing events, meetings, and drafting laws.

The president shall attend council meetings but cannot count as a voting member of the council.

The National Council can override a veto with a majority vote of 2/3.

LEGISLATION

National Council members and the President can draft laws. Once presented to the council, it is discussed by National Council members.

If the majority of members agree, the law is passed to the President; they can choose to veto the law or not.

In the event of a dispute, the President shall provide an interpretation. The National Council may override this interpretation by a 2/3 vote.

IV. FOREIGN AND INTERNAL AFFAIRS

PROVISION ON EXTERNAL AFFAIRS

The State of Colarus shall not recognize any nation(s) that does not meet these criteria:

1. Control of physical territory
2. Has a government
3. Has a permanent population

CONSTITUTION of the STATE of COLARUS

The Minister of Foreign Affairs must report to the National Council to discuss recognition of a nation.

PROVISION ON INTERNAL AFFAIRS

Land owners have the right to use their land; the government shall not interfere or trespass into privately owned land.

V. CONCLUSION AND AMENDMENTS

This document of the State of Colarus shall serve as the supreme law of all Colarusian land and people, and may be amended with a 70% majority vote from the National Council and the president.

Ministries shall be amended into this constitution when the National Council consists of at least one person.
